This policy outlines our handling practices and how we collect and use the Personal Data you provide during your interactions with us. In this Privacy Policy, 'Personal Data' means any information that can be used to individually identify a person and may include, but is not limited to, name, email address, postal or other physical addresses, title, and other personally identifiable information.

If you reside in the European Union ("EU"), United Kingdom, Lichtenstein, Norway, Iceland, or Switzerland, you may have additional rights with respect to your Personal Data, as further outlined below. These rights may include rights under the EU's General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), if you are a resident of the EU, United Kingdom, Lichtenstein, Norway, or Iceland.

Zucker Studio Inc. will be the controller of the Personal Data that is provided, collected and/or processed pursuant to this Privacy Policy, except where otherwise expressly stated. Collecting your Personal Data

We collect the following Personal Data about you when you use or otherwise interact with our Products:

- Name (First name/last name/full name)
- Title
- Email ID (both personal and professional)

Since Zucker Studio acts as a Data Processor, the Data Controller may choose to collect some of the following additional details.

- Profile/display picture
- Country, state, postcode or city of residence
- Login name, screen name, nickname, or handle
- Telephone number (Home/work/mobile telephone number)
- Postal or other physical address
- Date of birth
- Gender
- Name(s) of the school/university (including grades and graduation year)
- Name(s) of the workplace
- Job position/designation (including salary)
- Resume/CV
- Information related to social profiles, such as Facebook, Google, GitHub etc.
- IP addresses and other information collected passively, as further detailed in the “Passive Collection” section below

We collect and/or process your Personal Data as a part of the following activities related to our Products:

- Account registration
- Use of certain Product features
- Creating or taking tests
- Generating reports based on information collected from use of our Products
- Requesting service and support for our Products and providing such support
- Registering for an event (challenge, hackathon, etc)
- Participating in an online survey
- Participating in discussion forums
- Registering for newsletter subscriptions
- Customizing the content you see as per relevance

Processing your Personal Data

We will use your Personal Data only in accordance with our Privacy Policy. If you do not wish us to continue using your Personal Data in this manner, you can request that your account be deactivated from your profile settings .

We will only process your Personal Data if we have a lawful basis for doing so, which includes but is not limited to the following: consent, contractual necessity (i.e. processing that is necessary for the performance of a contract with you, such as your user agreement with us that allows us to provide you with the Products) and our legitimate interests or the legitimate interest of others (e.g. our users) such as:

- Personalizing, improving or operating our Products and business
- Understanding your needs and interests
- Fulfilling requests you make related to the Products
- Providing you with relevant information
- Complying with our legal obligations, resolving disputes with users, enforcing our agreements
- Protecting, investigating and deterring against fraudulent, harmful, unauthorized or illegal activity

We process Personal Data for purposes such as:

- Providing reports based on information collected from use of our Products
- Keeping you up-to-date about latest Product announcements, software updates, software upgrades, system enhancements, special offers, and other information
- Providing support and assistance for our Products
- Providing the ability to create personal profile
- Providing the ability to contact you, if required
- Providing customer feedback and support
- Providing and administering opt-in events or other marketing or promotional activities on Codenrock
- Being able to conduct questionnaires and surveys in order to provide you with better products and services
- Supporting recruitment inquiries
- Personalizing marketing communication and website content based on your preferences, such as in response to your request for specific information on products and services that may be of interest to you
- Meeting contract or legal obligations

Invites

If you choose to use our invite service to tell a friend about our products, you represent that you have your friend's consent to give us their name and email ID. We will automatically send your friend a one-time email inviting them to visit our website.

Choice

You can choose whether to provide Personal Data to Codenrock but note that you may not be able to access certain options, offers, and services if they require Personal Data that you have not provided. You can sign-up, and therefore consent, to receive email or newsletter communication from us. If you would like to discontinue receiving this communication, you can update your preferences by using the 'Unsubscribe' link at the end of such emails or by contacting us through email on support@codenrock.com.

Data subjects rights

You have certain rights with respect to your Personal Data as mentioned below. Please note that in some circumstances, we may not be able to fully comply with your requests or we may ask you to provide us with additional information in connection with your request, which may be Personal Data, for example, if we need to verify your identity or the nature of your request. In such situations, however, we will still respond to let you know our decision.

To make any of the following requests, contact us using through email on support@codenrock.com.

- Access : You can request more information about the Personal Data we hold about you. You can also request a copy of the Personal Data.
- Rectification : If you believe that any Personal Data we are holding about you is incorrect or incomplete, you can request that we correct or supplement such data. You can also correct some of this information directly through your user profile or profile/account settings after logging into Codenrock. Please contact us as soon as possible upon noticing any inaccuracies or incompleteness.
- Objection : You can contact us to let us know that you object to the collection or use of your Personal Data for certain purposes.
- Deleting data : You can request that we delete some or all of your Personal Data from our systems. While this will be done immediately, residual data may be saved in certain logs and this will be purged within a year after deleting

your data. Once your data is deleted, you will no longer have an account with Codenrock.

- Processing restrictions : You can always request us to deactivate your Codenrock account to restrict further processing of your Personal Data.
- Portability : You have the right to ask for a copy of your Personal Data in a machine-readable format.
- Withdrawal of consent : If we are processing your Personal Data based on your consent (as indicated at the time of collection of such data), you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Please note, however, that if you exercise this right, you may have to then provide express consent on a case-by-case basis for the use or disclosure of certain of your Personal Data, if such use or disclosure is necessary to enable you to utilize some or all of our Products.
- Right to file a complaint : You have the right to lodge a complaint about Codenrock's practices with respect to your Personal Data with the supervisory authority of your country or EU Member State.

Data retention

Your data is retained with Codenrock as long as you have a Codenrock account. You can request that we delete some or all of your Personal Data from our systems. While this will be done immediately, residual data may be saved in certain logs and this will be purged within a year after deleting your data. Once your data is deleted, you will no longer have an account with Codenrock.

Passive collection

Codenrock automatically collects some information about you when you use our Products, using methods such as cookies and tracking technologies (further described below). Information automatically collected includes cookies, page - view activity, geolocation data, Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, files viewed on our site (e.g., HTML pages, graphics, etc.), operating system, date /time stamp, and/or clickstream data to analyze trends in the aggregate and administer the website and/or Products. Such data does not have an expiry date and we don't delete this data. It is saved with us in log form or on on tools such as Google Analytics, LinkedIn Insights, Facebook Audience Insights etc.

Additionally , when you use some of our Products, network information such as Product - usage information is transmitted back to us . This information is transmitted back to us so that we can determine how users are interacting with our Products. This helps us in improving our Products and correct ing any problems that may occur.

Cookies and tracking technologies

Codenrock uses cookies or similar technologies to analyze trends, administer its website, track users' movements around the website, and gather information about our user base, such as location information based on IP addresses .

Users can control the use of cookies in the browsers that they use. Your browser may offer you a 'Do Not Track' option, which allows you to signal to operators of websites and web applications and services (including behavioral advertising services) that you do not want such operators to track your online activities and across different websites.

Our Products do not support 'Do Not Track' requests at this time, which means that we will collect information about your online activity both while you are using the Products and after you leave our properties.

Most web browsers automatically accept cookies but provide controls that allow you to block or delete them. For example, in most modern browsers, you can block or delete cookies by clicking Settings>Privacy>Cookies . Instructions for blocking or deleting cookies in other browsers may be available in a browser's privacy or help documentation.

Certain features of Codenrock Products depend on cookies and plugins. Please be aware that if you choose to block cookies and plugins, you may not be able to sign in or use those features. If you choose to delete cookies, settings and preferences controlled by those cookies, including advertising preferences, will be deleted and may need to be recreated.

Codenrock ("Company", "we", "our", or "us") collects information related to visitors and machines. Such information includes cookies, IP addresses, pageview activities, and geolocation data. The details of user activities on the Codenrock's website such as number of visits, time spent on the our website, and pages clicked are also collected.

The types of cookies used by us and their purpose are as follows:

Media cookies	Social media	products. Our website has social media cookies that relay your identifier information to your media account when logged in, in order to show relevant advertisements to you based on your activities on our website. The social media cookies are used for Facebook, LinkedIn, YouTube, and Twitter. If you no longer want to have these cookies enabled, you can change the settings from your device browser by logging into your social media account and changing the privacy settings.

Personal data may be freely provided by visitors or collected automatically while using any other platforms related to Codenrock.

Interest-based advertisements

We use cookies to gather information about your activities on our website in order to provide you advertising based on your browsing activity and interest. We also partner with third parties to either display advertising on our website or to manage our advertising on other sites. Some of our third party partners use technologies such as cookies and other technologies to gather information about your activities on this website, our affiliates' websites, and unaffiliated websites in order to provide you advertising based upon your browsing activities and interests.

Mobile application

When you download and use our Products, we automatically collect information on the type of device you use, operating system version, and the device identifier (or "UDID"). We send you push notifications from time-to-time in order to update you about any events or promotions that we may be running. If you no longer wish to receive these types of communication, you can turn these off from your device. To ensure you receive proper notifications, we will need to collect certain information about your device such as operating system and user identification information.

Geolocation

We collect information about where you are located when you are using our Products. We use this information for purposes such as optimizing your connection to our data center and suggesting customizations to your experience with our Products (e.g. your language preference, relevant events, challenges, hackathons, etc.). We share this information with parties such as our data center provider. If you do not wish to allow us to share your information in this manner, please opt-out by contacting us at support@codenrock.com.

Certain features of Codenrock products depend on geolocation. Please be aware that your experience on the website may not be optimal if you choose to block your geolocation identity. You may not be able to sign in or use those features, and preferences that are dependent on geolocation may be lost.

Sharing your Personal Data

We do not share, rent, or sell your Personal Data to third parties unless you have granted us explicit permission to do so.

We share Personal Data within Codenrock, its affiliated companies, and with third-party service providers for purposes of data processing or storage.

We also share Personal Data with business partners, service vendors and/or authorized third-party agents or contractors in order to provide requested Products or transactions, including but not limited to, hosting websites, hosting event and seminar registration and providing customer support. We provide the Personal Data to these third parties in order to complete/utilize the requested Product or transaction.

In some cases, we may choose to buy or sell assets. In these types of transactions, user information is typically one of the transferred business assets. Moreover, if we, or substantially all of our assets, were acquired, or if we go out of business or enter bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of us or our assets may continue to use your Personal Data as set forth in this policy. As required by law, we may respond to subpoenas, court orders, or similar legal process by disclosing your Personal Data and other related information, if necessary. We also may use Personal Data and other related information to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims.

We collect and possibly share Personal Data and any other additional information available to us in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of Codenrock's terms of service, or as otherwise required by law.

While navigating Codenrock's website or Products, you may be directed to content or functionality that is hosted by a third-party. When information is collected on behalf of Codenrock exclusively, Codenrock's Privacy Policy will be referenced and will govern how your information is used. For other, non-Codenrock sites or services, the site/service owner's privacy policy will be referenced. You should review such third party's privacy and security policies prior to use.

Security of your Personal Data

Codenrock is committed to protecting the Personal Data you share with us. We utilize a combination of industry-standard security technologies, procedures, and organizational measures to help protect your Personal Data from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure.
